### Addendum #3 – Questions and Answers

- 1) We understand from the job walk and other addendum that use of Shannon Road to access the project site is “use at your own risk”. Can you provide the construction access agreement with the Landowner/WDFW?
  - The Tribe has not yet received a Construction Access Agreement from the landowner – Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW). Based on the delay in receiving that agreement, the Tribe is extending the Proposal/Bid Submission Deadline to **April 14, 2026 at 2:00 PM PST**. When available, the WDFW Construction Access Agreement will be posted on the Tribe’s website and attendees at the mandatory job walk will be emailed a copy of the agreement.
  
- 2) Many insurance carriers are declining to quote Loggers coverage, as they require to write main lines of coverage, like General Liability. Would the Cowlitz Tribe accept the \$1M per claim/\$1M aggregate?
  - Loggers broadform insurance with the coverages as shown in the contract (\$1M per occurrence and \$2M Aggregate) are required.
