About: College Horizons is a non-profit organization that supports the higher education of Native American students by providing college and graduate admissions workshops to American Indian, Alaska Native, and Native Hawaiian students/participants from across the nation. Two programs are offered in the summer: College Horizons services current 10th-11th grade high school students and Graduate Horizons services college students and college graduates. College Horizons partners with 70+ colleges and universities who send admissions officers interested in engaging with college-bound high school students.

Native Forward Scholars Fund

About: This organization is located in Albuquerque, NM, but collaborates with enrolled members for Federally recognized Tribes, or descendants of a federally or state-recognized American Indian Tribe or Alaskan Native group within all 50 US states. They provide opportunities to over 30 academic year scholarships and additional funding for educational costs, internships, professional exams, emergency expenses & doctoral research. Students apply via their website with one application. Applications open January 1st and close June 1st each year.

About: The Washington Application for State Financial Aid (WASFA) is for people who choose not to file a [federal FAFSA application](#). If you have completed the FAFSA, you have already applied for federal and state financial aid and do not need to complete the WASFA unless your college asks you to.

People who complete a WASFA are applying only for state aid. If you are [eligible for federal aid](#), completing the FAFSA could maximize your potential financial aid awards.
